

HORSE BOARDING OPTION: For this camp only, we are making an option available for campers to bring their own horse. We will provide board for your horse at no charge provided your horse has no special needs and can stay with other horses. Any horses brought to the Ranch must be healthy and of a good temperament. They must be well broke and familiar with the camper riding them. ***STUDS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THIS RIDING CAMP.***

If you plan on bringing your horse to camp, we will need you to answer a few questions listed below. If you do not plan on bringing your own horse, we will assign you a Ranch horse for the week, and you can skip this section.

Board Info: Horse facilities are limited at the Ranch, so most horses being brought in will need to be pastured or penned with other horses. All horses being boarded at the Ranch will receive access to water, and salt. The Ranch provides oats or sweet feed, and will supply alfalfa/brome hay or pasture land for roughage. If special feed or hay is needed it must be provided and managed by the owner.

Tack Info: All horses being brought to the Ranch must have their own tack with a minimum of a properly fitting saddle, saddle pad, and bridle. You may also supply a halter, lead rope, grooming tools, and a riding helmet if you like, however the Ranch can supply them if needed. All tack must be clearly labelled with the riders name in a lasting, waterproof fashion.

Delivery and Pick Up Info: - Trucks and trailers may access our horse barn during registration hours on Monday (4:00PM till 6:00PM) and after the Rodeo program is finished on Saturday. Ranch horse staff will be available during those times to assist you.
